## MICROBLADING & TATTOOING

On the day of treatment, before your appointment do not drink coffee, alcohol or energy drinks.

On the day of treatment your brow area maybe red, raised, yore or swollen. This is normal.

YOU MUST NOT SMOKE, TOUCH THE AREA OR USE ANY CREAMS ON YOUR FACE ON THE DAY POST TREATMENT. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO KEEP THE AREA CLEAN TO AVOID INFECTION.

Post treatment Day I - Keep the area of the tattooing clean and sterile, do not touch with fingers. Please keep area clean and dry.

Post treatment Day 2- Apply The Glamour Garage Vitamin A and D oil every few hours to keep the area moist.

Repeat this until day 7. The area which has been tattoo'd will scab and flake, this is normal. Do not pick scabs.

Your colour will lighten dramatically when the scabs fall off, then slowly reappear over the next  $\lambda$  weeks. The colour may go completely and then it WILL reappear.

Please avoid sunbeds during this time. Do not use Vaseline on your brows. Vaseline can only be used on the lip area.

The Glamour Garage Vitamin Oil is £2.99 per sachet - this will last the 7 days post treatment. Please note post treatment aftercare accounts for 80% of the finished result for your brows.

You will need to come back for a top up in I months time. this is to seal in the pigment in your skin. This will be your 'top up'. We cannot perform the top up sooner than 4 weeks as it takes 4 weeks for the colour to come back through the skin.

Skin treats pigment like a splinter, it pushes it out - a second treatment seals in the colour allowing it to last up to 18 months for microblading and 2-3 years for the gun method.

The use of sunbeds and sun rays will shorten the lifespan of the pigment.

Everyones skin is different, some clients experience minimal colour loss between the first treatment and top up, others experience up to 75% colour loss. This is normal. The top up will then seal in the pigment.

Clients with oily skin may lose more colour than those with dry skin.

We cannot guarantee the lifespan of your tattooing.
